RESTORATION OF A 1930'S VILLA

Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat

This original 1930's villa in Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat has been completely renovated by the French architect Valerie Chomarat.

Formed by the master of British minimalism, architect John Pawson, she eliminates the superfluous and highlights the essential with delicacy.

Valerie repainted the salmon original facades in white, removed all shutters and completely redrew the swimming pool.

She revealed the art deco details with a minimalist gesture.

The client, a Polish couple in love with art, has acquired a sculpture from Igor Mitoraj when buying the house.

This sculpture was essential for Valerie in the design process : she situated the artwork right in the entrance, facing the horizon over the double high space.

The beautiful white marble creates the mood of the project - the position in the center of the house articulates the whole interior.
